## <u>Career Education – Dean Susan Sweeney</u>

- Our Regional Recovery and Equity Partnership grant has now entered its third year.
   This semester, we are excited to launch our Cybersecurity cohort. Gavilan College will handle the educational components and offer additional support, including gas cards, textbooks, counseling, and personalized assistance from our Cybersecurity Champion, Mario Ramirez.
- The Community Education program has already assisted 30 students with fees and materials for CMA, Phlebotomy, and Vet Assistant courses and will introduce gas cards this semester. We are also pleased to welcome our new Peer Mentor, Alejandro, who will provide bilingual support to our medical students both in and out of the classroom.
- Gavilan College's Water Resource Management Apprenticeship Grant has entered
  its third year. Our faculty champion, Catherine Ames, has aligned our plan with the
  Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS) and expects project approval by the end
  of September. The next step will be to establish 25 apprenticeship placements
  through collaborations with local water agencies.
