Plan is shared with BOT.












Planning Principles

The principles described provide the framework for the recommendations for the Campus. They were developed early in the planning process and were used as a guide for the development and evaluation of early concepts and ideas.



PROGRAMMATIC NEEDS

- Replace inefficient and underperforming facilities
- Integrate instructional and student support services
- Position GC to maximize funding (state and local)



COMMUNITY PRESENCE

- Increase visibility
- Strengthen connections with surrounding communities
- Improve community access to College events and performances



ACCESS + WAYFINDING

- Develop welcoming + inviting campus entries
- Develop and clarify circulation patterns
- Enhance wayfinding and campus organization



CONNECTIONS

- Organize campus functions to support the guided pathway model
- Develop new east/west connections, while strengthening existing primary pedestrian routes



SENSE OF PLACE

- Create a sense of belonging and pride
- Create a collegiate campus identity



HEART OF CAMPUS

- Develop indoor and outdoor spaces to support collaboration



Open Space Network **Entry Grove**









- Sloped Seating Area







- Retain and Reinforce Character of Exsiting Grove
