Mumps or MMR	or • Two (2) doses or mumps or • One (1) positive mumps titer
Measles or MMR	<ul> <li>Two (2) doses of MMR or</li> <li>Two (2) doses or measles or</li> <li>One (1) positive measles titer</li> </ul>
Varicella	<ul> <li>Two (2) doses or varicella or</li> <li>One (1) positive Varicella titer</li> </ul>
Hepatitis B	<ul> <li>Three (3) doses of hepatitis B or</li> <li>One (1) positive Hepatitis B titer</li> </ul>
Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap)	• One (1) dose within the last 10 years
Tuberculosis Skin Test	• TB (PPD) skin test done or QuantiFERON. If positive must have chest X-ray results within (90 days) of clinical start.
Influenza (Flu Shot)	Most current flu season
COVID -19	Covid- 19 Vaccine + Booster
CPR	Must be an American Heart Association course - BLS Provider
Ten Panel Drug plus Alcohol Screening	Completed via Castle Branch.
Background Check	• Must be completed via Castle Branch. LVN and RN programs only.
