# STEP-UP BRIDGE PROGRAM

Fast-Track your BSN with the CSULB School of Nursing! The Step-Up Bridge Program is an enhanced experience *while* completing your ADN Degree. This program allows current ADN students to complete non-clinical BSN courses prior to being admitted to the CSULB Online RN to BSN Program. This program is aimed at students who have completed their 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of an ADN Program\*.

#### **ADMISSION CRITIERIA**

- Completion of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and currently enrolled in an ADN Program\*
- Minimum of 2.75 GPA in Nursing courses and 2.75 or higher for your overall GPA

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Students who meet admission criteria will be allowed to take courses that will count toward a RN to BSN Degree at CSULB.
- Enrollment will through the College of Professional and Continuing Education Division of CSULB.
- All students start with NRSG 309 Dimensions of Professional Nursing as the first class.
- Students admitted to this program are not guaranteed admission to the RN to BSN Online or On Campus Program and additional requirements may be necessary for the BSN degree.
- Courses completed through this program are automatically articulated to the RN to BSN Degree
  Program. Other, non-nursing courses are subject to review and approval by Enrollment Services.
- Funding and financial aid are the responsibility of the applicant (fees are \$600 per credit hour).

#### APPLICATION TO THE STEP-UP BRIDGE PROGRAM

 Candidates must apply via the Online Applications by April 1<sup>st</sup> for admission with the following summer cohort.

#### Students in the Step-Up Summer Bridge Program may take the following courses:

- NRSG 309 Dimensions of Professional Nursing (required first course)
- NRSG 305 Pathophysiology (optional in your first semester)
- NRSG 312 Health Assessment (optional in your first semester)

## TRANSITION TO THE RN TO BSN PROGRAM

Students admitted to the Step-Up Bridge Program must apply to the RN to BSN Online or On Campus Program, but are not guaranteed admission. Applicants should consult <a href="www.assist.org">www.assist.org</a> to determine course articulations. When you are ready to apply for the RN to BSN Online or On Campus Program, you will need to:

- Submit separate applications for the RN to BSN Online or On Campus Program
- Identity courses you have taken during the Step-Up Bridge Program
- Meet CSULB requirements (120 total credits taken and articulated).
