	<p>Our gainful employment outcomes all contained cell counts that were too low to report based upon the criteria stated within the annual update.</p> <p>It is worth noting that a large number of our "active" courses have not been offered in many years; while they remain in our catalog, they do not have active and ongoing assessment as the courses are more than four years old. This is the reason for the discrepancy between our total active courses and total active courses with ongoing assessment.</p>
