Change Description: This course is designed to introduce students to the basic sociological concepts and theories of race, ethnicity and cultural identity in U.S. society. Students will examine race, ethnicity and cultural identity as social constructs that permeate social structures and institutions, and how they change over time and space. Over the semester students will critically analyze the ways which race, ethnicity, class, and gender/sexuality continually shape peoples lives and experiences. While the class focuses on U.S. societies, students will also critically compare and contrast race and ethnicity in other societies.
