NEW COURSE PROPOSAL - SECOND READING

CD 35 Establishing Positive Behavior in All Classrooms 3 Units, 3 Lec

Description: Introduces the student to realistic and effective strategies for guiding all young children's behavior. This course demonstrates best practices for establishing and maintaining age and developmentally-appropriate, productive behaviors among all children in a classroom setting. Course topics include environmental, developmental and special needs sources of maladaptive and challenging behaviors, guidelines for selecting and implementing strategies for positive behavior change for all children, and developing healthy communication strategies with families, program staff and children.

CD 36

Description: This course gives the early education teacher or interventionist specific curricular skills to meet the development needs of all children in the classroom. Emphasis is placed on working with the child within his/her family system and culture. Students will review typical and atypical development in all domains, hone observation and documentation skills, learn how to design and implement curriculum and intervention strategies and communicate effectively with parents and para-professionals.

ESL 777 ESL Lifeskills 1 0 Units, 5 Lec

Description: This is the first course in a series of survival English classes for students with very little oral or written English competency. It will give students basic vocabulary and familiarity in life skill areas such as the family, food, health, and occupations to manage in the real world. The course emphasizes oral communication and integrates listening, reading, and writing.

ESL 778 ESL Lifeskills 2 0 Units, 5 Lec
