New Courses

BUS 700 Entrepreneurship (Summer 2019), 0 Units, 3 Lec, 0 Lab Justification:

We are offering this course to provide community members, including immigrants, with access to business materials and information that will help them be successful in developing and operating their own small businesses. This course will be offered in conjunction with BUS 701 to complete a course of study which will result in the awarding of a Noncredit certificate.

BUS 701 Small Business Ownership (Summer 2019), 0 Units, 3 Lec, 0 Lab Justification:

We are offering this course to provide community members, including immigrants, with access to business materials and information that will help them be successful in developing and operating their own small businesses. This course will be offered in conjunction with BUS 700 to complete a course of study which will result in the awarding of a Noncredit certificate.

Added WELD 702 as an Advisory. This is 1 of 3 new WELD courses which will make up a new Welding Technology program Non Credit Certificate of Completion.
