There is an Information Competency Exam up on the Intranet for review. There is no mandate to implement the Information Competency requirement at this time.

#### C. Comments on Curriculum

M. Dwyer discussed several issues related to items on the Agenda: the high reading level listed for several courses, the listing of Content during Week 18, and Method of Evaluation percentages. It was agreed that texts in some areas would have a high reading level due to the nature of the material in the discipline. Content for Week 18 should reflect the 2-hour Final Exam that is normally scheduled for each course. Course Outlines approved with other content scheduled during that week would need to be modified. When using the Methods of Evaluation form, a total of 100% in the left column does not make sense since it does not give any flexibility in grading.
