 - 3. Faculty are reminded that October 1, 2004 will be the deadline for articulation of new courses next Fall.

D. VanTassel discussed the benefits of cross-listing class. Some disadvantages were also presented. Within the past few years, many cross-listed courses were "divorced" according to criteria agreed upon at that

time.
