There is obvious concern about several issues that relate to curriculum and we need to continue the discussion here. The Curriculum Committee, as a

sub-committee of Senate, could make a recommendation to Senate. Is there a way to accomplish student success without the ALC?

- C. Courses to be Updated - Kathleen asked about the usual practice with courses to be updated. Do we take action throughout the year to inactivate or update courses as needed. Susan explained that departments are encouraged to update those courses currently being taught, and courses to be taught in the near future. We actively seek to identify those courses that need to be inactivated and we do a mass inactivation at the last meeting of the fall and spring semesters. We make sure that courses that are “cold” are inactivated. Articulation drives the updating of courses. We check courses that have not been updated for 5 years. SLO’s have also pushed courses to the inactivation list, since all active courses need to assess their SLO’s.
