This class is cross-listed in Political Science; students need to be aware as to the course content and transferability as a major course or as an elective. This is a stand-alone course, but AJ would like to put this into their degree/program at some point. On the forms: Grading should be letter grade *or* pass/no pass and is not repeatable. These should be corrected when filling out the form for the second reading.
