A. New Business

1. NEW COURSE PROPOSAL – FIRST READING

a. JLE 164 Crime Scene Investigation

Course is designed for new evidence technicians - a POST course - teaching basic skills to identify and process evidence.

MSC (M. McKenna/E. Luna). Vote: unanimous.

b. JLE 165 Philosophy of Leadership

This is the POST title for the course. Assists students in identifying and developing leadership styles, and understanding how they relate to supervisory and leadership skills. Variable course with 16 - 120 hours.

MSC (E. Luna/S. Carr). Vote: unanimous.

2. <u>NEW COURSE PROPOSAL – SECOND READING</u>

a. PE 82 Circuit Training

Combination of aerobics and resistance training, using a rotation of stations, alternating between cardio and muscle training. Course will be taught on a rotating basis by one of the F/T instructors.

MSC (F. Lozano/E. Luna). **Vote**: unanimous.

3. MODIFICATION OF EXISTING COURSE – FORM C

a. AJ 20 Juvenile Law and Procedure

Update SLO's, textbook and content. Includes juvenile law and court procedures. No textbook is listed - a required binder of printed materials compiled by the instructor is sold in the bookstore. This is not GE applicable, so the GE-LO's do not apply.

b. CD 11C Supervision of Adults: The Mentor Teacher

c. CD 13 Infant and Toddler Care

Update textbook, SLO's, content and methods of evaluation. Not written or set-up for use as the cultural diversity requirement, but could be written that way in the future.

A. Physical Education and Athletics Department Name Change

This proposal has made its way through the various shared governance committees on campus, including approval by the Academic Senate. Other community colleges across the state have recently made this change - Cabrillo did so last year in time for their new catalog. Kinesiology is the art and science of human movement. KIN will be the new course designation. It will require all PE Courses to be re-created as Kinesiology courses, then resubmitted to the Chancellor's Office. It is more than just a "name thing" - it is more professional and brings our degrees in line with the degrees at the 4-year and graduate level. Students would receive an AA in Kinesiology with an emphasis in either the Education Option, Sports Management Option, or Sports Medicine Option. This will be an action item at the next Curriculum meeting.
