  - BluePrint for a Safer Economy no longer in effect
  - Pending additional announcements taking place this day.
- Pending Guidance from:
  - CDPH & Cal OSHA regarding Institutions of Higher Education
  - Department of Industrial Relations/ Cal OSHA Emergency Temporary Standards
  - Santa Clara County Public Health Department
  - US CDC



# Reopening Stages

STAGES	INSTRUCTION / SERVICES	CAMPUS ACCESS	VISTORS	SCREENING
I	All classes and services online	Limited	Must be preauthorized	Daily check-in protocols and symptom self-screening. Check-in at South Gate and at building.
II	Most classes online, essential in-person classes only	Limited	Must be preauthorized	Daily check-in protocols and symptom self-screening. Check-in at South Gate and at building.
III	In-person classes permitted with restrictions	Expanded	Appointment or specific service hours	Daily check-in protocols and symptom self-screening. Stop at South gate and check-in at building.
IV	In-person classes with restrictions	Open with restrictions	During hours of operation	Daily check-in protocols and symptom self-screening. Check-in at building.
V	Return to standard operations	Unrestricted	During hours of operation	Symptom self-screening.

# Current Stage – Stage 2 until June 14

- Most classes online – essential in-person classes only.
- Campus access limited
- Preauthorization required for campus visits
- Pre-screening required prior to coming to campus
  - [COVID-19 Daily Self Assessment Questionnaire](#)
- Check-in at South gate and at each building (QR codes on doors – scan with phone)
- Guidelines continue through June 14, 2021
- Safety protocols in place:
  - Mask-wearing
  - Social distancing
  - Disinfection and sanitization of surfaces

# Next Stage – Stage 3

June 15 – August 23

- Most classes remain online
- Campus access expanded
- No preauthorization required for campus visits
- Pre-screening required prior to coming to campus
  - [COVID-19 Daily Self Assessment Questionnaire](#)
- Stop at gate and check-in at each building (QR codes on doors – scan with phone)
- Guidelines continue through August 23, 2021
- Safety protocols in place:
  - Mask-wearing
  - Disinfection and sanitization of surfaces

# Following Stages - 4 & 5 August 24 -- TBA

- Stage 4
  - Begin Date: August 24, 2021
  - In-person classes permitted with restrictions.
  - Campus open with restrictions.
  - Campus visits during hours of operation.
  - Pre-screening required prior to coming to campus
    - [COVID-19 Daily Self Assessment Questionnaire](#)
  - Check-in at each building (QR codes on doors – scan with phone)
- Stage 5
  - Projected Start Date: January 1, 2022
  - Return to standard operations.

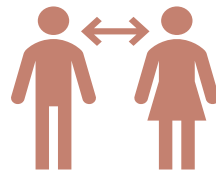
