Vision/Narrative

The Distance Education Program is responsible for the technology, guidance, training, and support needed for the instructional program to deliver curriculum, asynchronously or synchronously, in an online environment, videoconferencing environment or other distance learning formats. This includes supporting technical needs of distance learners and instructors at all three campuses (Gilroy, Hollister and Morgan Hill) as well as any other geographical location that our students and faculty may be accessing our online environment from. It also includes training to teach online using a variety of technologies and resources and orientations to online learning for students. Currently we are supporting approximately 5000 students a year. We have also had tremendous growth in this area since 2009. However, we have not increased our staffing levels. Currently we have 1 F.T. faculty and one less than part time adjunct. It is anticipated that with additional staff hours we will be able to support the continual anticipated growth, as well as maintain retention and success rates that are on target with state figures, while continuing to deliver quality instruction.

Another issue with growth has to do with planning. Currently planning for DE stems from individual faculty and the DE Committee. Consequently, a growth plan, direction or input from the organizational structure is needed to ensure we are optimizing enrollment and providing alternative course delivery that meets the needs of our community.

The D.E. program recently relocated to the Library mezzanine, which will definitely improve our access to our faculty, staff and students. We merged with the SRC to become the Teaching and Learning Center. While this is very beneficial to the college, since no extra staffing has been provided, it means the current D.E. staff has taken on additional duties for the TLC (former SRC) needs. Some needs in both areas will go unmet as we continue to grow unless additional hours in current staffing are provided for.

Progress:

Closed: 15-16 Progress has been made but still relevant objective. Student support services has begun to include planning for DE students in their program plans. More online student support services have been added, such as online tutoring. Exploration of the delivery of synchronous 2-way interactive courses delivered to our satellite sites has begun. Evaluation, assessment and planning on-going.

The Academic Senate has facilitated DE discussion on their agenda at several of their meetings and as a result resolutions were passed adopting documents such as The D.E. Master Plan, D.E. Faculty Handbook, and other policies and procedures which were then forwarded through shared governance, including the President's Council and presented to the Board. Accreditation has also facilitated the discussion regarding planning and support for student services, as well as program planning to evaluate any needs for substantive change.

However, planning for community needs still has not been done, especially regarding how DE may be utilized at our satellite campuses for growth.
