

Learning Commons Instruction

Vision/Narrative

The Learning Commons collaborates with faculty, staff, and representatives from other academic and student services to strengthen students' capacities to be self-directed learners and to develop strategies for succeeding in an academic environment, including efficacy, agency, and scholarly habits. Much of the work in the Learning Commons promotes and supports collaborative, independent learning, information literacy, and use of technologies in order to meet program and institutional learning outcomes.

At the heart of the Learning Commons are learning activities developed in collaboration with instructors and student tutors. These activities are designed to bridge the gaps between classroom instruction and academic support and range from unstructured use of the flexible, technology-rich environment to fully-supported class work sessions that target discipline-specific or cross-disciplinary skills students need to succeed in an academic environment. This year, the Learning Commons seeks to strengthen partnerships with faculty and other campus resources to develop learning activities that map to targeted SLOs, PLOs, and ILOs in order to create shared and consistent approaches to connecting academic support to classroom instruction.


