Specific areas of focus music theory, history, song writing, electronic music/digital audio and piano, guitar. The music corriculum provides a program for the students who wish to (1) pursue an advanced degree in music, (2) broaden a general knowledge of music, (3) develop performance skills, (4) become a professional musician, (5) prepare for a career as music educators, (6) prepare for a career in digital recording. The experienced instructors create an environment that both fulfills General Education Requirements and offers students intensive preparation for transfer into both university and vocational level programs.






