

Fine Arts: Music Instruction

Vision/Narrative

The Music Department maintains a place at Gavilan College as an avenue for nuturing the broad and passionate interests to performers, composers and theorists. At Gavilan College all these aspects form a community dedicated to furthering the knowledge and passion for music. The Music Department offers a wide range of courses for students seeking professional careers in music, as well as those seeking enrichment. Specific areas of focus music theory, history, song writing, electronic music/digital audio and piano, vocal, guitar. The music corriculum provides a program for the students who wish to (1) pursue an advanced degree in music, (2) broaden a general knowledge of music, (3) develop performance skills, (4) become a professional musician, (5) prepare for a career as music educators, (6) prepare for a career in digital recording. The experienced instructors create an environment that both fulfills General Education Requirements and offers students intensive preparation for transfer into both university and vocational level programs.

Feedback from Supervisor / Dean

Music is a key area of study for both majors and non-majors and brings enormous benefit to the campus and the community. Support for the facilities will enhance the program and lead to increased numbers of Music majors.

Many of the objectives in the plan read more like activities that might support a broader objective, such as "update facilities and equipment." The objectives as written don't clearly lend themselves to what are the programs broader goals. Where does the program want to be in one to three years, what objectives will lead to those goals, and what activities support those objectives? Additionally, the program would benefit from reflecting on data and outcomes to support some of the stated objectives, such as the effectiveness / conversion rate for community outreach events and enrollment indicators for evaluating progress on optimizing the schedule.
