<u>Dr. Kathleen Rose</u> – President's forum is today in the outdoor classroom during college hour. She will be discussing big issues of the campus including communication and shared governance. Stresses that the information gathered from meetings should be reported back to their constituent groups. She will also be discussing data security and making sure that all student data is protected. The joint resolution in support of undocumented students will be presented to the Board of Trustees next Tuesday. Women's History Month: she will be moderating a panel on March 20th and wishes to extend the invitation to all students. Senior staff and the bookstore will move back to the student center by May 1st while the rest of the services will be moved in June to avoid disruptions.

<u>Ryan Shook</u> – Presented and opportunity for a grant with Lime Green Ribbon to further the mental health awareness to Gavilan. The grant is of \$500 and will be used in supplement to ASGC and Health Service funds for food and promotional materials. ASGC will have to put together a history/background section for the grant proposal.
