1 COS: Cosmetology Building

The Cosmetology Discipline offers instruction to students in all phases of cosmetology. The program fulfills the requirements set forth by the California State Barbering and Cosmetology Program and is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. Students can get their hair and eyebrows done here for a lower price! Ask about their hours!

2 BU: Business Building

These are some of the Degrees and Certificates Offered in our business department: Business Administration, Accounting, General Business, General Office Skills, Medical Office, Real Estate, Retail Management, Economics, Business Computer Applications, Computerized Accounting, Liberal Arts with Business Emphasis and more!

3 SS: Social Sciences Building

The Social Sciences Building is the central hub for the Gavilan's humanities and social science programs. This building houses departments such as psychology, sociology, political science, and economics, providing classrooms, laboratories, and dedicated spaces for faculty and student collaboration.

4 SC: Student Center

Our Student Center is a place where students can lounge, do their homework, and eat food. It is open until 9 PM Monday - Friday. The cafeteria and student government office are located in here as well. Our cafeteria offers hot meals to students that can be paid via a Meal Card (you can pick up at the Food Pantry) (Discussed more in Food Pantry section)

5 Bookstore

At the bookstore, students can buy their textbooks, school supplies, souvenirs, snacks, general merchandise such as sweaters, waterbottles, and more! The hours of the bookstore are posted in their window.

6 AD: Administration Building

The Welcome Center, Counseling, Financial Aid and Executive Office of the President and Vice President are located in this area. At the Welcome Center, peer mentors help students book appointments with counselors, assist with financial aid applications, and print student IDs. Have any questions? We are here to help.

7 GY: GYM and APE: Adapted Physical Education Center

As you cross the bridge, you'll approach the main Gym and Adapted Physical Education (APE) Center. These facilities form the hub of campus recreation and wellness. The Gym features basketball courts, a running track, tennis courts, football field, soccer field, and hosts a variety of group fitness classes. The adjacent APE Center provides specialized equipment, including an heated pool for aquatic exercise, a dedicated weight room, and inclusive fitness classes.

8 Tennis Courts and Pool

This is the back side of the gym. It offers a better view of outdoor recreation spaces. Adjacent to the main gym, you'll find tennis courts and an outdoor swimming pool, as well as baseball and soccer fields, and a track. Please note that use of these outdoor facilities is restricted to registered students, faculty, and staff - visitors will need to check in at the Gym or APE Center to gain access.

9 LS: Life Sciences Building

The Life Sciences Building is the center of our biology, chemistry, and environmental science programs. This building features research laboratories, specialized equipment, and collaborative spaces for hands-on learning. Students in these disciplines can utilize the building's resources to conduct experiments, analyze data, and bring their scientific ideas to life.

10 PS: Physical Sciences Building

Just down the path from the Life Sciences Building is the Physical Sciences Building. This building houses the physics, astronomy, and engineering departments. It is equipped with high-performance computing resources, and dedicated project lab to support technical coursework and research initiatives. Students can access these facilities to gain practical experience in their STEM disciplines.

11 MA: Math Building

This building houses our STEM Center, MESA program, and Math Lab. A student can get tutoring and homework assistance on all STEM subjects. MESA is an income based program that is open only to qualified students, and the STEM Center and Math Lab are open to all students! Please check the hours posted on their entrance.

12 HOB: Health Occupations Building

The Health Occupations Building is the central facility for Gavilan's nursing, radiologic technology, respiratory therapy, and other allied health programs. Students in these fields benefit from specialized simulation labs, clinical skills training suites, and cutting-edge medical equipment to develop the hands-on competencies required for their future careers.

13 Food Pantry

Gavilan's food pantry provides a wide variety of non-perishable food items, fresh produce, and other essential supplies at no cost to enrolled students facing food insecurity. Eligible students can pick up a meal card every 2 weeks to pay for their hot meals at the cafeteria. All students can register to pick up fresh produce twice a month.

14 CDC: Child Development Center

The Child Development Center provides high-quality early childhood education and care, while also housing the ESL (English as a second language) and non-credit departments, offering English language instruction and GED preparation. ESL and GED classes are free!

15 Student Success Center

The Student Success Center provides a comprehensive range of support services for students, including a dedicated resource center called El Centro that assists with basic needs like food, hygiene, transportation, and housing. The facility also features a career and transfer center, offering career exploration, internships, and guidance for students transitioning to four-year institutions or the workforce. Career fairs are held on campus often.

16 GECA: Gilroy Early College Academy

The GECA campus is an accelerated ninth through twelfth grade program designed to foster academic and career success. GECA operates as an educational partnership between Gilroy Unified School District and Gavilan College. Highschoolers can receive their high school diploma and associates degree at the same time. Visitors please do not walk on the GECA campus, as we do not want to disturb them in session.

17 LI: Library

The Library is a place where students are encouraged to explore, discover, investigate and develop research skills for personal, professional and life-long learning. The Library has hardcopy & digital textbooks, a laptop loan program, and a writing/tutoring center. The Library also provides free wifi, free printing, and librarians for any additional help.

18 HU: Humanities

The Humanities building on campus has opportunities for civic engagement; and an understanding of history, culture, and humanity. This department provides certificates, degrees, and careers in education, social justice, public policy, journalism, and more. Some classes we offer in the Humanities building are English, Introduction to Cinema, Journalism, etc.

19 AR: Arts

The Arts building on campus is home to new and innovative ideas, nurturing students' personal and creative journeys. The arts programs here cultivate each student's capacity for producing fresh, imaginative work. Upon completing our arts programs, students will be prepared to continue their personal, artistic journeys. The Arts department offers classes such as drawing, painting, design, sculpture, photography, and ceramics.

20 TH: Theater

The Theater building on our campus is a hub for cultivating self-confidence, creativity, and teamwork skills through class projects and performances. Our theater students have the opportunity to collaborate with the vibrant South Valley Communities for shows and productions. Some of the theater classes offered in this building include Oral Interpretation, Acting I, Acting II, and Costume Design, among others.

21 MP: Multi-Purpose Building

The Multi- Purpose Building houses the HR department, IT department, mailbox, and performs business related operations.
